



Insert Size Guide

Several factors will determine what type and what size of insert may fit into your existing fireplace. Having as much information about your fireplace available is extremely helpful to the sales representative to guide you to the products that will work for your application from the start of the sales process.

You can use this guide to document information about your existing installation.

NOTE: Even if you are not able to get the information, it is common practice for most fireplace stores to send someone out and preview your existing fireplace and its installation prior to the insert installation to ensure that the product you have chosen will fit properly.

What type of fireplace do you currently have?

_____ Masonry fireplace made from brick or stone with a clay flue.

_____ Manufactured fireplace made with sheet metal fire box with metal flue.

If it is a manufactured fireplace, there should be an identification tag on either the upper left or upper right hand side in the smoke shelf area or behind the screens.

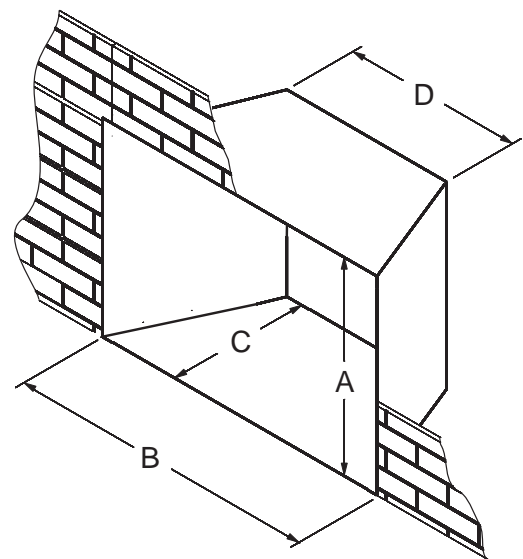
